## Welcome to Walcheren

Walcheren is bordered by water: two sides face the North Sea and another the Westerschelde estuary. From its beaches you can watch the seagoing ships pass just off the coast.



## History

All the way back to Roman times, the area around Walcheren was inhabited and Domburg was an important trading town. Walcheren became a county after the 4th century, and a circular stronghold to defend it against the Normans was built in the 9th century. Middelburg arose around that time, named for its location between Domburg and Souburg. In the 16th and 17th centuries, it grew to become one of the largest port and trading towns in the Dutch Republic.

Formerly an **island, Walcheren has been a peninsula since the end of the 19th century. That's** when the Sloedam was constructed and the railway from Zuid-Beveland was extended to Vlissingen.

During the Second World War, Walcheren was crucial to controlling the port of Antwerp. German occupiers turned Walcheren into a large fortress with around 200 bunkers. Fierce fighting broke out around the Sloedam, taking the lives of many soldiers. The allied forces flooded much of Walcheren to weaken the German position, and it was finally liberated on 8 November 1944.

Walcheren largely escaped damage in the North Sea flood of 1953. The subsequent construction of the Veerse Dam, part of the Delta Works, created the Veerse Meer lake, now a popular water sports destination in Zeeland. The tradition of ring riding is especially popular in Walcheren: almost every town has its own competition. This involves a rider on an **unsaddled galloping horse trying to put a lance through a ring. A knight's challenge.**

## Villages and towns

**Zeeland's** capital city, Middelburg, is centrally located on Walcheren. Nearby is the town of **Vlissingen, with its famous boulevard along the Westerschelde. In Vlissingen's harbour, the** ships come so close to shore that you can almost touch them. The seaside town of Domburg has always been a popular place for bathers. It also attracted many artists in the early 20th century, **who came to see the beautiful 'Zeeland Light'.**

## Domburg

Domburg is the oldest seaside resort on the Walcheren coast. In 2013 Domburg was given **the official status of 'health resort'.** This means it meets all the international criteria set out by the German Spa Association. The sea water, the climate and the natural resources of the soils here have health-giving properties. Together with Cadzand, Domburg is the only Dutch seaside town to have this designation.

### Badpaviljoen Domburg:

Het **badpaviljoen** (or 'beach pavilion') is an iconic building in Domburg's dunes. The first beach pavilion was built on the same site in 1837. It served as a coffee house and a bathhouse. In 1983, the present building became a listed monument. It now houses a restaurant. From the beach terrace there are fantastic views along the coastline.

Domburg has many other historic buildings, such as the old town hall, the Weltevreden mill and the water tower.

### Middelburg:

A historic city with a rich architectural heritage. The city has an illustrious past to which **today's townscape bears witness.**

**Middelburg owes its name to the fact that it was once the middlemost 'burg'** - or stronghold - on the island of Walcheren. In the 9th century, when the Vikings invaded, ramparts were **constructed along the island's coast. Middelburg was the middlemost of these and so** acquired its name. Once the danger subsided in the Middle Ages, the town developed into a trading centre and in 1217 it was granted a municipal charter.

When the Dutch East India Company (VOC) was in its pomp, Middelburg became one of the most important cities in the Netherlands. In the space of 200 years, the shipyards here turned out no fewer than 300 seagoing vessels. These ships sailed to Asia to ply trade in spices, textiles and porcelain. There are still many buildings in Middelburg today to remind us of this Golden Age.

Second only to Amsterdam, Middelburg once had the largest number of historic buildings. Even today, there are still over 1100 listed structures in the old town. During the Second World War, Middelburg suffered much war damage. The city fire of Middelburg (shelling and bombing) in 1940 reduced a large part of the historic inner city to ashes. After the war, the city was rebuilt along traditional lines.

For both Juniors and Youth the programmed beaches are:

Training day (October 16<sup>th</sup>) programmed venue: map 1 Zeven golven, Domburg Village  
Competition day 1 (October 17<sup>th</sup>) programmed venue: map 7 Zoutelande  
Competition day 2 (October 18<sup>th</sup>) programmed venue: map 5 Dishoek Vlissingen  
Competition day 3 (October 19<sup>th</sup>) programmed venue: map 6 Nollestrand Vlissingen  
Competition day 4 (October 20<sup>th</sup>) programmed venue: map 2 Banjaard beach.

Borselle (map 4), Westkapelle (map 8) and Dijkwaarde (map 3) are **alternative** locations.

**NOTE: depending on weather and catch results the 5 programmed beaches might be used on other days than scheduled. And, if necessary, due to weather conditions, the alternative beaches will be used.**

Rules:

Only the FIPS-M rules will be applied. It is downloadable on the website: <https://www.fips-m.org/statutes-rules-gb>

Method of fishing:

Fishing at the seaside: 20 meters will separate each fisherman in each sector. It is forbidden to enter the water above the knee. Fishing must be done on the dry part of the beach.

Accounting of catches:

The championship will take place in "catch and release" however all the catches will be counted. All fish will be measured and released. **All Fish above 15 cm count (1 point per cm (rounded up) + 10 points per fish). Fish under 15 cm = 1 Bonus point**



Fish species present, the number of stars corresponds with the abundance of the species One \* means less present and \*\*\*\*\* stands for frequently present.

## BALTS

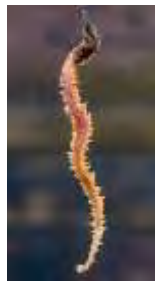
All the participating teams will be provided with bait. In the team captain meetings the place and time where the bait will be handed over will be announced. This applies to the training day, October 16<sup>th</sup> and the competition days 1 to 4, on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>.

Each competitor gets a package per day that contains:

50 lugworms (zeepieren)



100 grams ragworms (slikken)



10 Zeeuwse tappen (black lug)



10 razor clamps (mesheften)



Disclaimer: the contents of this package might be different if circumstances (weather) make it impossible to get to certain bait.

Teams will be able to order extra bait if they arrive earlier in Domburg. The details of the provider will be send later.

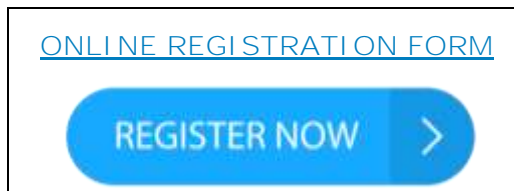

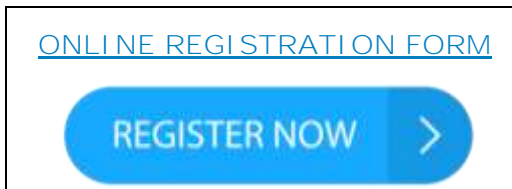

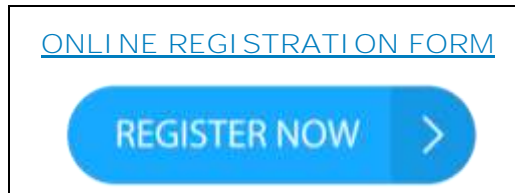

## ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION TUE REQUESTS



A Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) is a certificate granted by an anti-doping organization (IF for international-level athletes, NADO for national-level athletes and MEO for athlete participating in an MEO event). The certificate is for a set prohibited substance, in certain dosages, with a limited period of validity. An application for a TUE must be based on a documented medical condition and diagnosis and the TUE will only be granted under strict criteria laid out in the International Standard of TUEs.

Athletes must absolutely avoid taking a medication with a prohibited substance without a valid TUE.

The presence of a prohibited substance or its metabolites **or markers in an athlete's sample** without a valid TUE is an Anti-Doping Rule Violation (ADRV), as are the use or attempted use of a prohibited substance or a prohibited method, possession, administration or attempted administration.

Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List <https://www.wada-ama.org/en/prohibited-list> with their prescribing physician before taking a medication to ensure that no prohibited substance is contained in the medication needed.

Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method (listed in this link: <https://www.wada-ama.org/en/prohibited-list> ) must apply to CIPS for a TUE following the CIPS strict TUE application process. He shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website: <https://ita.sport/resource/international-testing-agency-therapeutic-use-exemption-tue-application-form/>

The TUE request has to be sent to the following address: [tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport)

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs.



## **ESSENTIAL ANTI-DOPING ADVICE**

Athletes are reminded if they take any medication they must check it against the WADA Prohibited Substance & Methods list.

Particular attention must be paid to the use of anti- hypertensive agents, especially diuretics, which are popular in singular preparation and/or in a combination with other normally permitted drugs.

Diuretics are always forbidden.

For these reasons, it is necessary for every athlete or National Federation to check the list for prohibited substances and process a TUE as necessary. The Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) must be granted before taking a prohibited medication.

An application for a TUE must be requested 30 days before taking part in the championships. The application forms must be filled in carefully with your physician/doctor who must authorise the application. A physician's certificate or prescription on its own does not mean that the athlete has permission to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application should be completed either in English or French and sent directly to the office of the CIPS President.
