

Fish 15cm or over

Fish 15cm or over, cm will be rounded up to the next full number. 1 point awarded per cm Length 10 points awarded per fish.

Fish under 15cm

Fish under 15 cm will be awarded 1 point

The following fish are excluded:

- Fresh Water Eels to comply with Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) EEL Management Protection Plan.
- Sea Trout to comply with Irish Law.





ESSENTIAL ANTI-DOPING ADVICE

Athletes are reminded if they take any medication they must check it against the WADA Prohibited Substance & Methods list.

Particular attention must be paid to the use of anti- hypertensive agents, especially diuretics, which are popular in singular preparation and/or in a combination with other normally permitted drugs.

Diuretics are always forbidden.

For these reasons, it is necessary for every athlete or National Federation to check the list for prohibited substances and process a TUE as necessary. The Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) must be granted before taking a prohibited medication.

An application for a TUE must be requested 30 days before taking part in the championships.

The application forms must be filled in carefully with your physician/doctor who must authorise the application. A physician's certificate or prescription on its own does not mean that the athlete has permission to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application should be completed either in English or French and sent directly to the office of the CIPS President.
